

Continuing Education Scholarship for Non-Traditional Students

The LPC Memorial Scholarship Committee recognizes that our current scholarship program is not designed to aid adult students who wish to continue their education or students who are only able to attend school part-time. This reimbursement scholarship is available for members of Lakeside Presbyterian Church who wish to further their academic goals or obtain an additional licensure or certification in order to enhance their ability to improve their quality of life.

LPC will, **upon receiving a tuition statement or a receipt of payment**, offer reimbursement assistance of \$50 per undergraduate credit for up to a total of 24 credits per academic year. This would amount to a maximum total of \$1200 per year.

LPC will, **upon receiving a tuition statement or a receipt of payment**, offer reimbursement assistance of \$100 for each graduate credit for up to a total of 12 credits per academic year. This would amount to a maximum total of \$1200 per year.

The reimbursement amounts are subject to change and will be set annually by the Memorial Scholarship Committee.

Candidates wishing to pursue additional training in a non-academic workshop, seminar, or training may also be eligible for financial assistance. LPC will, **upon receiving a tuition statement or a receipt of payment**, offer reimbursement as deemed appropriate by the Memorial Scholarship Committee as it considers these applications on a case by case basis.

To continue receiving these awards, applicants will need to show that they are making satisfactory progress in their program.

This continuing education opportunity will only be available to applicants who are members of Lakeside Presbyterian Church.
