

LPC Troop 15 Eagle Scout Scholarship

The Troop 15 Eagle Scout scholarship is a one-year non-renewable award that is administered by the Lakeside Presbyterian Church Memorial/Scholarship Committee.

1. **To be eligible for a scholarship, each applicant must:**
 - a) be an active member of Troop 15 that has achieved the rank of Eagle Scout and who is graduating from high school or obtaining an equivalency certificate (GED)
 - b) have achieved a grade point average 2.5 or higher (on a scale of 4.0) in high school coursework, or a comparable performance for an equivalency certificate (GED)
 - c) have received acceptance to an accredited college, university or vocational/technical school for the ensuing school year
 - d) has enrolled as a full-time continuing student for the period that the scholarship is awarded

2. **Application for scholarship is made by submitting the following items:**
 - a) letter of request to the Scholarship Selection Committee, accompanied by the following essentials on the completed application form:
 - applicant's educational and future goals
 - anticipated field of study
 - involvement in church and school activities
 - a personal statement why he or she should be awarded the scholarship
 - b) **please be certain to address all items on the 5 page application**
 - c) high school transcript, equivalency certificate or transcript from post-secondary school now attending, remitted directly to the Church Office marked "**Scholarship Selection Committee**" by institution issuing transcript or certificate by the first day of June
 - d) letters of reference or recommendation from each of the following:
 - a high school teacher or counselor addressing the student's performance; involvement in school activities; quality of course work completed; and potential for successful academic performance in a college, university or vocation/technical environment
 - a non-related adult, as a character reference
 - the Scoutmaster of Troop 15 addressing the applicant's: 1) involvement in Troop 15, 2) role model potential for younger scouts, 3) potential for success in school, 4) educational and future goals and 5) character
 - e) interview with the Scholarship Selection Committee when deemed appropriate, to answer questions determined by the committee
 - reminder: all the above materials for application must be received prior to an interview

3. The minimum award for this scholarship will be \$500. The actual amount may vary from year to year contingent upon the number of applicants, renewals and/or funds available for all LPC Scholarships. Awards will be paid at the beginning of each continuing school year.
4. The Scholarship Selection Committee shall consist of all members of the Lakeside Presbyterian Church Memorial/Scholarship Committee. The decision to award scholarships will be made by a majority vote of a quorum of said Committee.
5. COMPLETED APPLICATIONS FOR SCHOLARSHIPS MUST BE IN THE CHURCH OFFICE MARKED “**Scholarship Selection Committee**” BY JUNE 1ST.
6. SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENTS MUST HAVE THEIR GRADE REPORT TRANSCRIPT SENT DIRECTLY FROM THE SCHOOL REGISTRAR’S OFFICE TO THE CHURCH OFFICE MARKED “**Scholarship Selection Committee**” AT THE END OF EACH SCHOOL YEAR BUT NO LATER THAN THE FIRST DAY OF JULY.
7. The Scholarship Selection Committee may, at its discretion, consider special cases that do not fit the criteria set forth above.
